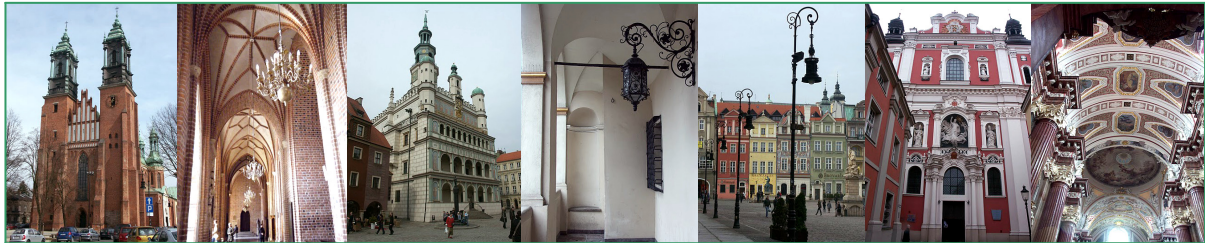




# CIRCULAR 1

## 13<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL LUPIN CONFERENCE 6-10 June, 2011, Poznań, Poland

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to participate in the 13<sup>th</sup> International Lupin Conference "Lupin crops - an opportunity for today, a promise for the future", organized under the auspices of the International Lupin Association by the Polish Lupin Association and the Institute of Plant Genetics, Polish Academy of Sciences. The meeting will provide an international forum for collegial interaction, for those interested in the current role of lupins in animal nutrition, human diet and sustainable agricultural systems. It will allow researchers and industry professionals to present recent findings in the form of lectures and posters, and to take on new challenges in lupin genetic improvement as well as agronomic use. The official language of the Conference is English.



### CONFERENCE LOCATION

The conference will be held in Poznań, a strong academic center, a dynamic industrial city and a beautiful town with a long, turbulent history of more than 1000 years. It is the capital of Wielkopolska (Great Poland), a region of Poland renowned for high standards and long-standing traditions in agriculture. ## CALL FOR PAPERS

The organizing committee is hereby calling for abstracts from those wishing to present oral as well as poster contributions.

**Abstracts** should be submitted electronically, as an e-mail file attachment to [ILC2011@igr.poznan.pl](mailto:ILC2011@igr.poznan.pl) by **15 March 2011**. Files should be in MS Word or other Open Office-readable format, named with the first Author's family name. Page in A4 format, all margins 2.5 cm, double line spacing. The whole abstract should not exceed one page.

Title - Arial 12 point; bold; left aligned

Authors - Arial 12 point; left aligned; presenters name underlined

Affiliations - Arial 10 point; left aligned

Corresponding author's email - 10 point; left

Basic text - Arial 12 point; left aligned.

The authors will be responsible for the text of the abstracts.

### Oral presentations

- Keynote addresses 30 min
- Oral presentations 15 min
- Presentations may only be given as PowerPoint presentations. Prepare your presentation as a single PowerPoint 2007 file to run on an IBM compatible computer with the Windows operating system.
- MacIntosh computers will NOT be available.

### Posters

- The posters will be displayed throughout the Conference and two specific poster sessions will be organized.
- Posters 70 cm wide x 100 cm high will be displayed on free-standing boards.

The Organizing Committee intends to publish a **book of abstracts** which will be delivered to the Participants during the Conference, as well as a **post-conference monograph** of peer-reviewed contributed papers. As the monograph should be issued in a short time, all the participants are requested to submit the final version of the their papers during the Conference.

All speakers/presenters must be registered participants and have paid their fees for the Conference. Each registered Participant may present two contributions (oral or poster, subject to acceptance of the Organizing Committee) and submit two abstracts to the Book of Abstracts. However, only one full paper of each Participant (as a first author) will be published in the Conference Proceedings.
