

Guidelines for the exam

Human genome variability in health and disease
(the person responsible for the course – prof. Ewa Ziętkiewicz)

The written exam has a form of a project of research studies and the topic must be connected with the lecture series “Human genome variability in health and disease”, according to the instructions below:

1. Please give your name, institution and title of your PhD project.
2. Project proposal should contain:
 - title,
 - background,
 - hypothesis,
 - specific aims,
 - methodology,
 - significance,
 - literature,
 - abstract (max 200 words).
3. Your proposal must be different from the topic of your PhD thesis.
4. Your exam proposal should be related to the topics of the lecture.
5. Keep the text of your proposal concise – do not write more than **4 standard pages** (font 12, single space, standard margins).
6. Submission's **deadline is 11 March**. Please send pdfs files by e-mail to Professor Ewa Ziętkiewicz (ewa.zietkiewicz@igcz.poznan.pl)
7. You will get scores by the end of March.
